I am confident that our trade and investment ties will continue to grow beyond the current level of 850 million euros. There is room to do more — to diversify our cooperation in renewable energy, smart mobility, cybersecurity, and the digital economy.

The success of this forum would not have been possible without the dedicated work of SARIO, Portuguese Trade&Investment Agency (AICEP), and our Embassy of the Slovak Republic in Lisbon, as well as the generous support of the City of Lisbon and the Beato Innovation District for hosting this event.

This gathering is more than an economic forum — it is a celebration of partnership and trust. Together, we can build bridges of innovation between the Atlantic Ocean and the heart of Europe.
